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Operational Manual for the HS/HSC Changer

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ABOUT THIS MANUAL

This manual will provide the operator with important information about installing and maintaining the HS-2, HS-3, HSC-2, or the HSC-3 Changer. General information is provided for the Hopper, Validator, Stacker, and Controller. However, if additional information is needed for these components, please refer to the appropriate manual. To obtain assistance from the manufacturer, please call (800) 837-5561 or (419) 867-4858.

When calling for assistance, it is very important to have serial numbers readily available. Please take the time to record these numbers in the spaces provided. Note that models HS-2 and HSC-2 have two Hoppers, and that models HS-3 and HSC-3 have three Hoppers.

<u>I. INSTALLATION</u>

MOUNTING

Cabinets are pre-drilled for wall mounting or mounting on an optional base. Bases are pre-drilled for securing to the floor. Do not use leveling screws when fastening to the floor. Changers mounted on bases should be securely fastened to both the floor and the wall. Fasteners to be used should be recommended by your engineer as to strength and suitability for floor and wall composition. Hamilton will not be responsible for injury due to improper installation.

For mounting in wall, cabinet size is 41-3/8" H x 20" W x 12-7/8" D.

ELECTRICAL

This currency changer is operated on 120VAC, 60Hz. This changer uses a 6 AMP CIRCUIT BREAKER for use with two Hoppers, and an 8 AMP CIRCUIT BREAKER for use with three Hoppers. Unit may be hard-wired with conduit if desired.

A GROUND FAULT INTERRUPTER IS REQUIRED. The recommended Ground Fault Interrupter should have the following specifications:

- 120VAC
- 15 AMP
- 6-10mA trip level
- Should <u>not</u> trip when power is removed from circuit.

<u>II. MAINTENANCE</u>



CAUTION! Do not use oil, grease or solvents on any part of this changer except as clearly specified in this manual, the hopper manual, the validator manual or in the stacker manual.

HOPPER

Any lubrication in the Hopper can result in a faulty payout. Empty the coins from the Hopper and vacuum once a month. Use a soft brush to loosen dirt. Refer to the Hopper Manual for details on maintenance.

VALIDATOR

Refer to the Validator Manual for lubrication instructions and all other information. THE VALIDATOR SHOULD BE SERVICED ANNUALLY TO MAINTAIN MAXIMUM PERFORMANCE. ONLY A TRAINED TECHNICIAN SHOULD DO THIS WORK.

STACKER

Refer to the Stacker Manual for information regarding maintenance.

CONTROLLER

The microprocessor based Hamilton C2000 Controller monitors the systems of the HS-2/HS-3 and the HSC-2/HSC-3 Bill Changers. If a problem is detected, the Controller will shut the machine down and display the appropriate error code. Refer to the C2000 or Audit Pro Controller Manual for error codes.

The twelve DIPswitches located near the Computer Reset Button select the payback of coins on multi-Hopper change units. There is no need to change the switch settings on a typical Model HS-2/HS-3 or HSC-2/HSC-3 Changer, as they are set to the payout arranged when the order was placed with Hamilton. Included in the C2000 manual are sheets listing the switch settings of most typical payout arrangements for your particular model Changer. Please remember that the Coin Hoppers may not have the proper Coin Wheel if changing the coin type you are vending. These switches are to remain in the positions set at the factory unless you are not satisfied with the current payout setting. If none of the included standard settings meet your wishes, contact Hamilton for assistance. YOU MUST HAVE THE CONTROLLER MODEL NUMBER READY.





APPENDIX C

BILL DENOMINATION MYLAR INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



- 1. Loosen and remove the NUTS from the BALL STUDS.
- 2. Remove the BALL STUDS from the FACE PLATE.
- 3. Insert the BILL DENOMINATION MYLAR between the FACE PLATE and the PLASTIC PANEL until the holes in the BILL DENOMINATION MYLAR line up with the holes in the FACE PLATE.
- 4. Reinsert the BALL STUDS into the front of the FACE PLATE, through the BILL DENOMINATIN MYLAR and the PLASTIC PANEL.
- 5. Replace the NUTS on the BALL STUDS and tighten.
