EVH Changer Operational Manual

GENERAL INFORMATION

Important Note: Two keys are furnished for door lock and separate keys for stacker lock - Make a permanent record of key numbers.

INSTALLATION

Cabinets are a pre-drilled for wall mounting or for mounting on optional base. When installing on a wall, fasten securely, using best type fastener suited to wall construction. If mounted on a base, add weight to base for ballast or fasten the base to floor or wall.

ELECTRICAL

This changer is operated on 120 VAC. A GROUNDED RECEPTACLE IS REQUIRED. Unit may be hard wired with conduit if desired. The changer uses a 2 AMP FUSE.

OPERATION

BILL ACCEPTANCE

Acceptance of particular bill denominations are preset at factory, though can be changed. Bills can be accepted face-up, in either direction.

Note: A special model validator is used in this changer. A different model **cannot** be substituted. Refer to Model/Serial number.

HOPPER

Loading/Unloading

Load coins into hopper by sliding hopper forward. Pour coins into hopper. Unload by gliding hopper out of machine and pour into container.

Empty

RED

Hopper holds about 1000 quarters or \$250. Hopper is empty when coins are no longer touching metal plate located on backside of hopper bowl. There will be approximately 50 coins left on bottom. The OUT OF SERVICE LAMP will flash rapidly, the validator will not accept bills.

INDICATOR LAMPS

There are 3 lamps on power panel:

YELLOW - Lit continually, flashes with each coin paid.

GREEN - Lit when hopper is full, off when hopper is empty. May flash during payout as coins move on sensor plate.

- Lit when hopper motor is running.

There are 2 lamps on side of validator:

AMBER - Flashes continually when changer is in service, awaiting bill insertion.

RED and AMBER are lit continually during payout and FLASH WHEN HOPPER IS EMPTY. With a malfunction the RED lamp will flash the error code.

OUT OF SERVICE LAMP

Off during normal operation, flashes error codes 5, 15, 16, 17, 18, and every 12 seconds simultaneously with validator lamps.

RESET BUTTON

Resets only error codes of 5, 16, 17, 18 flashes. Other error codes are reset by unplugging machine.

SERVICE

Only the following error codes can be resolved by the operator.

- 4 Flashes Check for bill or piece of bill stuck inside validator. Open stacker and look inside.
- 5 Flashes Stacker is full or blacker plate is cocked sideways.
- 16 or 17 Flashes Coins jamming or no hopper motor run. Check for lodged coins. Check payout switch. Red lamp on power panel should light when hopper is running.
- 18 Flashes A bill had become jammed inside the validator had gone into the self-clear mode but was unable to clear bill.

 Remove bill by opening stacker or pulling out of front.

For all other error codes which do not reset - contact HAMILTON or a FACTORY AUTHORIZED SERVICE CENTER.
